

2020 SAN SIMEON PASO ROBLES PETITE SIRAH



Region/Vintage Notes

Our 2020 San Simeon Petite Sirah is sourced from our Maddalena and Stefano estate vineyards in the El Pomar AVA in the Paso Robles appellation. Due to the darkness in the grapes skin, Petite Sirah is often used as a blending grape, but when grown in the proper soils and climate this varietal can be magnificent on its own. Our Petite Sirah vines benefit directly from the Paso Robles climate that features warm, sunny days, cool afternoon breezes and even cooler nights during the growing season. Rolling hills with well-drained soil produce highly concentrated grapes which translate to intense and powerful wines. The 2020 vintage is well-balanced, intense, and vibrant vintage that will age well.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

Deep, dark and richly textured, this wine is anything but “petite”. Aromas of blueberries, blackberries, and black currants greet the nose and draw you in. This wine evolves in the mouth with a core of mature black fruits that show incredible concentration. 18 months of aging in a combination of French and American oak barrels brings spicy complexity to this full-bodied, well-balanced wine. With nice acidity adding a pleasant punch, the wine finishes long with mature and balanced tannins.

Sustainability

Sustainability is a top priority at San Simeon. Our Paso Robles Vineyards are certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA). At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional use.
